### Korea

- A. Energy Subsidies
  - 1. Provision of Electricity for LTAR
  - 2. The GENCOs Provide Electricity to KEPCO at Prices that Do Not Reflect Fair Market Value, which Constitutes an Upstream Subsidy for Korean SSLP Producers
    - a. A countervailable subsidy is provided to KEPCO in the form of electricity for LTAR
    - b. The price SSLP producers pay for electricity is lower than it would be in an arm's length transaction; and the GOK sets electricity prices to guarantee that the low-price benefit to KEPCO is passed through to SSLP producers
    - c. The *ad valorem* countervailable subsidy rate on electricity, multiplied by the proportion of the total production cost of SSLP, is equal to or greater than one percent
